ACTIVITIES:	Pre-lesson 1. Pupils will be given a Google Meet link for online class. 2. Teacher will be waiting for around 2 minutes for everyone to enter and get ready for today's lesson 3. While waiting for the pupils, teacher will say hello and ask how everyone is doing during the pandemic. 4. Before class starts, teacher will ask pupils to turn their camera on and ask them to mute their microphones. 5. Teacher then explain today's topic, The Wonders of Nature. 6. Pupils need to volunteer and answer what is nature from their perspective when they get the question by teacher.			
	Lesson delivery Activity A: 1. Teacher will start by sharing screen with the pupils. 2. It will show a YouTube video about "Top 10 Most Beautiful Places in The World" 3. The video will be played for around 8 minutes. 4. After the video has finished, pupils need to answer the questions given in chat box. - Has anyone of you have been in this place?			

- From this video, which place you want to go the most and why?

7. Do you prefer at the beach or forest?

Activity B:

1. Teacher then explain to pupils about next activity.
2. Pupils will be given a link to Signature Technology website in chat box.
3. There will be a podcast and pupils will need to listen to the podcast. Time given will be 5 minutes.
4. After listening to the podcast, Teacher will ask pupils some questions. They may speak or type in chat box to answer.

- What is the podcast about?
- Where did the podcaster go?
- Has anyone in class ever gone caving or hiking before the pandemic?

5. A QR code will be given to pupils.
6. A short quiz will be held online on the Quizziz website the questions are based on podcast that they have listened just now.
7. Pupils may ask about the vocabulary that they might not understand.
8. Scores will be revealed of those who have the highest marks.

Activity C

1. Teacher will ask pupils to go back to Signature Technology's website again.
2. Below podcast, there are worksheets for pupils to answer.
3. For those who can print, they may print and paste on their exercise book after answer the questions.
4. But for those who do not have a printer to print, they may copy by hand on their exercise book.
5. Once completed, pupils will be evaluated and teacher will give them feedback.
